### **Pathways towards achieving Construction Procurement Reform and Intelligent Commissioning**

Thank you for your recent application to the RIBA Research Trust Awards 2012. The Awards committee met yesterday to review the applications and I am delighted to say they have agreed to award you £9,350 towards your research project. Two members of the awards panel, Murray Fraser and Rob Mitchell, would however like to meet with you to clarify a few developmental points about your proposal. I have copied them both in to this email – would you be able to suggest a few dates that would be convenient for you for this meeting?

I have attached the Terms and Conditions and Conditions of Payments forms which you completed with your application. I would be grateful if you could confirm if you would like to accept the award, and agree to use the funds as specified on your application.

The payments of the award will follow the instalments as stated. You should request these payments from me on the specified date.

We usually require an update on the progress of the research projects after the first 12 months. However as your project is due to be completed within one year, I will contact you after 6 months for this progress report. I may also request an update from your supervisor.

My colleague John-Paul Nunes and I administer the awards from the RIBA Education Department, so we will be keeping in touch with you for the duration of the award. We will be preparing a press release to announce the outcome of the judging, so I would be grateful if you could email me a short summary (250-300 words) of your research to include on this press release and on the RIBA website, along with a short biography and any relevant images. The summary should be suitable for a wide audience and explain what you will be doing and why it matters. I would be grateful if you could send this to me by the end of next week so that we can prepare the press announcement in good time.

Congratulations on being selected as a recipient of a RIBA Research Trust Award – we received 80 applications for six awards, so it is great credit to you that your proposal stood out to the Awards Committee.
